

**PARTICIPANTS NEEDED: Adults who have lost a family member to suicide**

*Family Members' Perspectives of System Responses to Suicides*

We are looking for volunteers living within Edmonton Zone, to share their stories about how their family member who died by suicide, and themselves, interacted with the health care system.

Are you someone who:

- Has a family member who has died by suicide more than 3 months ago?
- Knows that your family member interacted with the health care system (e.g., family doctor, emergency department, hospital inpatient, outpatient services, etc.)
- Had regular contact with your family member so that you are aware of their interaction with the health care system?
- Is 18 years or older?

Being in this study is your choice. If you choose to participate, you will be asked to take part in one in-person interview approximately 1.5 to 2 hours long. The interview will be in Edmonton.

By taking part in this study, you will help us to identify strengths, areas of improvement and ideas for change for our health care system.
